Alan and Janette Blackburn Scholarship: (21BLAK)

- Applicant must be a graduating senior or have graduated from a Montana high school.
- GPA must be 3.5 or above
- Applicant must have graduated in the upper 21% of their class.
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

Cowboy Christmas Ball Scholarship - Sweetgrass High School: (21CCBS)

- Applicant must be a graduate of Sweet Grass County High School.
- Applicant must have completed—or be in the process of completing—one third of the required credits toward an undergraduate or graduate degree at an accredited college, university, business or vocational school.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need and academic achievement.
- Applicant must provide a Letter of recommendation from Academic Advisor
- Applicant must provide employment history
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

D.A. Davidson Education Memorial Scholarship: (21DADF)

- Minimum GPA of 2.5 (high school and/or college)
- Applicant's parent must be employed by D.A. Davidson for a minimum of one-year at the time of first award check is issued, and parent must work at least 30 hours a week.
- Adopted and Stepchildren of employees are eligible.
- Applicant can be full-time or part-time (minimum of 6 credits).
- Applicant must demonstrate academic achievement.
- Applicant must provide the following:
 - Financial Need
 - Long-term goal and objectives
 - Participation in community activities
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

Eldon & JoAnn Kuhns Family Scholarship - Montana Society CPA: (21MCPA)

- Applicant must be a Montana High School graduate and be a Montana resident.
- Applicant must be majoring in Accounting.
- Applicant must be at least a junior in standing with at least one semester of coursework remaining.

- Applicant must demonstrate a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Must be a student member of the MSCPA.
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

Fred & Gloria Thaut Webber Scholarship: (21WEBR)

- Applicant must be a current or former resident of Big Horn County or Carbon County, or a current or former student of Custer Public Schools in Yellowstone County.
- Applicant must be one of the following:
 - A high school senior with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above
 - A full-time college student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above
 - A non-traditional college student enrolled or planning to enroll as a full-time student, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Physically disabled or learning challenged students may be exempt from above as circumstances warrant.
- Selection is based on the following factors: financial need, participation in school, church and community activities, participation in 4-H as a current or former member or leader, and long-term goals to pursue a career in education, agriculture, agriculture-business or agriculture-engineering.
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

Glacier Bancorp Inc. Mick Blodnick Scholarship: (21GBBS)

- In-state and out of state students eligible to apply.
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 (high school and/or college)
- Scholarship recipients must be currently employed (or have a parent employed) by Glacier Bank Corp (at the time the first award check is issued).
- Adopted and Stepchildren of employees are eligible.
- Full-time or part-time students are eligible.
- Awards will not be based on a geographic, however geographic diversity is highly desirable & be considered.
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

***NEW*Joseph and Eveline Kyle Fund: (21JEKF)**

- Applicant must be pursuing undergraduate, graduate academic or vocational degree
- Non-Traditional adult student/re-entry students
- Applicant must be a permanent resident of Deer Lodge MT
- Applicant must be attending school full or part-time (min. of 6 credits)
- Applicant must attend either traditional or online programs at an accredited institutions
- Demonstrate financial need
- No minimum GPA requirement for students beginning their first year in college

- Awarded applicant can Re-Apply:
 - Awardee must maintain a minimum GPA 2.25
 - Submit most recent transcript
 - Applicant must complete application
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

Marcia Edsall Scholarship: (21MEBP)

- Applicant must be female.
- Applicant must be a resident or former resident of Gallatin County, Montana and a graduate of Bozeman High School or Belgrade High School.
- Applicant must be a full-time student entering their *junior or senior* of any post-secondary school in the United States.
- Applicant must have maintained continuous enrollment at a post-secondary school, unless medical or financial difficulties required an interruption in continuous enrollment.
- Applicant must demonstrate a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for all post-secondary studies.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology

Kay McMillan Nursing Scholarship: (21KMSE)

- Applicant must be one of the following:
 - A graduating senior enrolled in the pre-nursing program at Montana Tech
 - A current pre-nursing student at Montana Tech
 - A nursing student in the Montana Tech Nursing Program
- Strong preference for nontraditional students, i.e. older, re-entry students, especially those who have overcome significant barriers to return to school
- Demonstrated financial need
- Preference for Butte-Silver Bow County High School graduates
- Minimum pre-nursing (high school) GPA of 2.0
- Demonstrate a strong commitment to community health
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology
- Re-apply scholarship year after year up to 4 years
 - Applicant must re-apply to the application

Seeley Family Memorial Scholarship: (21SFMS)

- Student must be a member of the Helena First Presbyterian Church.
- Graduating senior or graduate from a Helena high school
- Minimum grade point average of 2.0
- Demonstrated financial need

- Demonstrated good character

Sweet Grass County High School Centennial Scholarship: (21SCHS)

- Applicant must be a graduate of Sweet Grass County High School.
- Applicant must have completed at least one year of study and be a student in good standing at an accredited 2 or 4-year program at a college, university, business or vocational school.
- Applicant must be actively pursuing a degree or certificate or may be a student who is seeking an advanced degree.
- Selection is based on the following additional criteria: financial need, academic achievement, and school, community and church activities.
- Applicant must be attending a regionally accredited public or private college, university or college of technology
